# Benefits of Project



- Construct a sidewalk on the west side of Chain Bridge Rd. between Old Town Fairfax and Rust Hill Place
- Stabilize the embankment along the West side of Chain Bridge Rd.
- Upgrade associated utilities
- Add landscaping and lighting





# Scope of Work

- Construct over 1000 LF of retaining wall and 750 LF of brick fence
- Place over 700 SY of brick sidewalk and curb and gutter
- Relocate existing water main from North St. to Whitehead St.
- Install over 700 LF of storm drainage pipe
- Relocate various underground utilities



# Traffic Management



- Access to entrances will be maintained at all times
- Work will be executed in a timely manner to reduce full detour closures
- Various construction work will be performed at night to reduce impacts
- Northbound Chain Bridge will be detoured a majority of the project

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- Advanced notification to adjacent owners for disturbances and parking restrictions

# Estimated Construction Timeframe

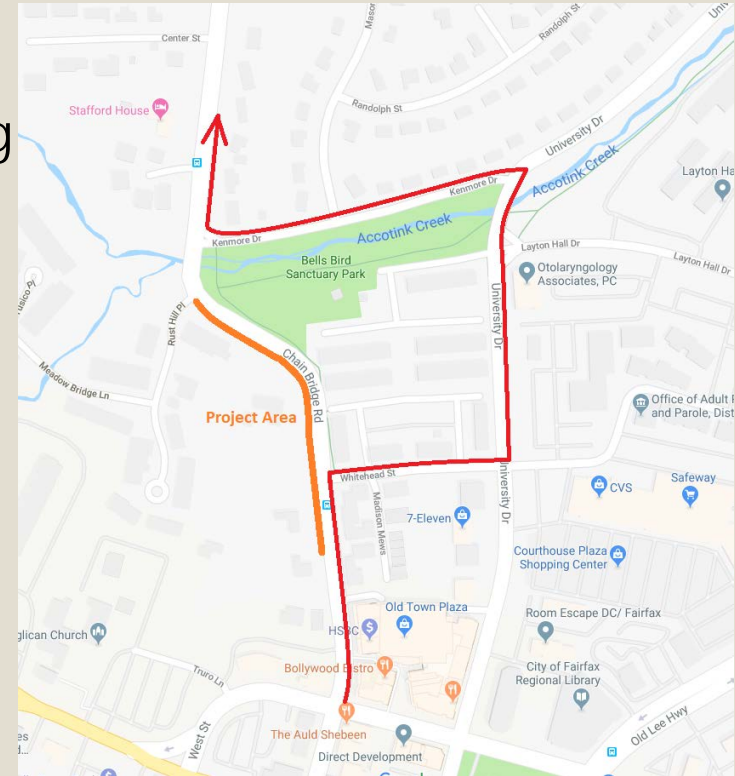


## May 2019 to May 2020

May 2019- Install 12 month lane shift along Chain Bridge Road/Route 123

June 2019-May 2020:

- Tree removal/management
- Relocating water main and various utilities
- Installing storm drainage improvements
- Constructing retaining walls and a brick fence
- Adding Lighting and landscaping
