

Old Town Visioning Committee Notes from August 1, 2019 Meeting

PART 1: Refining Goals for Guiding Principles

Build Strong Partnerships (w/GMU, Fairfax County, State, etc.)

- 1. Bring GMU into Old Town and create a partnership that provides redevelopment, education, and places to live for students, faculty, staff, and City residents
- 2. Create a transportation plan between the City and GMU
- 3. Encourage incubator space create innovation and maximize research opportunities
- 4. Create a strong liaison with the state to benefit infrastructure, business development, and tourism

Grow Business

- 1. Substantially increase funding for and provide incentives to increase the variety of independent retail shops and businesses
- 2. Increase the City's resources to support business owners
- 3. Explore grant programs and other state and federal funding opportunities
- 4. Establish entertainment anchors to activate Old Town and attract patrons on evenings and weekends
- 5. Increase residential density in Old Town to support the Old Town business community

Enhance Culture

- 1. Partnership with GMU to attract multiple entertainment venues
- 2. Partnership with Fairfax County to enhance historical interpretation
- 3. Focus on utilizing technology to promote culture and history
- 4. Create street art and building art program
