#### **CALL TO ORDER**

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 8:51 a.m.

#### **PRESENT**

### APPROVAL OF MINUTES OF JUNE 12, 2019 ELECTORAL BOARD MEETING

The Chairman moved the minutes for the June 12, 2019 Electoral Board meeting be approved as corrected during the meeting. The Vice Chairman seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

### APPOINTMENT OF OFFICERS OF ELECTION

The DE/GR stated there were no new applications to consider at this time.

### BRIEF UPDATE FROM THE DE/GR

The DE/GR stated there were several on-going activities to recruit new officers of election. Those activities included:

- Advertising in City Scene;
- Sending recruitment data to presidents of the various homeowner associations (HOA) in the City;
- Possible participating in the "Rock the Block" event; this would require a canopy, banners and
  officers of election to staff the event.

The DE/GR reported that she spoke with one of the scooter companies operating in the City to do a promotional for Election Day, 'take a scooter to the polls'.

Ike has been assigned lead for the office of the DE/GR to hold a sticker contest for the 2020 election; details are being finalized.

The ballot order for the November general election has been finalized; 11,100 ballots have been ordered.

A VRAV presentation is scheduled to be made by the DE/GR for September 4, 2019.

A meeting with IT & election staff is planned for September 12, 2019

Risk limiting audit related meetings will be scheduled in the next few months. The DE/GR will inform the Board of any in which she is invited to participate. Additionally, there are Council Governments (MWCOG) operations meetings which also may be attended.
