## Minutes of the March 5, 2007 Meeting

Sick Leave: The City package

The Board agreed to authorize 2 Full Time Assistant Registrars and part time employees as needed. The current General Registrar has the same authority.

The Board wishes the General Registrar to train at least one Assistant Registrar to be fully capable of assuming the General Registrar functions. The Board believes that such an employee should be designated Deputy Registrar.

The Board wishes the General Registrar and all Assistant Registrars to embark on a course of training leading to certification. The Board will seek funding to achieve these goals and does not wish trainee to be out of pocket.

The Board agreed to contact the unsuccessful candidates to inform them of our decision.

The Board discussed the importance of moving expediently in the matter of having a new General Registrar.

The Board discussed Mr. Gerald T. O'Dell's failure to file timely Campaign Finance Reports and pay civil penalties assessed for these failures.

The Board agreed to pursue the above matter with all due diligence.

The Board agreed to meet March 16, 2007 at 2:00 p.m.
