City of Fairfax Telecommunication Facility Application Process

The following table is to help you identify which types of applications you need to submit and where to email the applications. In all cases a Zoning Permit for Non-Land Disturbance (**ZP NLD**) and Building Permit (**BLD**) are required.

Drawings should say 'replacement' when antennas and/or equipment are being replaced. The processes described below do not apply to small cell antennas in the City of Fairfax right-of-way that are reviewed by the Department of Public Works through a **right-of-way license agreement and permit**.

¹ Small cell requirements: 1) no portion exceeds the permitted height of the zoning district; 2) each antenna is located inside or could fit in an enclosure of no more than 6 cubic feet in volume; and 3) all other wireless equipment associated with the facility has a cumulative volume of no more than 28 cubic feet (Code of Virginia §15.2-2316.3, 15.2-2316.4, 15.2-2316.4:1, 15.2-2316.4:2 and 15.2-2316.4:3).

BAR approval is needed whenever antennas and/or equipment are visible from right-of-way. **Bonding** is required prior to approval of any permit to ensure that measures can be taken by the City of Fairfax, at the applicant's expense, should he/she fail to remove the facility or its components.
