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Application Instructions

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Lines 1 and 2: Self-explanatory.

Line 3: Provide an email address to receive timely communications from the Office of Code Administration.

Lines 4 through 10: Self-explanatory.

Line 11: Describe the site (e.g. 911 address or property description)

Line 12: Self-explanatory

Line 13: A "designated individual" is defined as "a person in possession of a Virginia *Background Clearance Card* (BCC) or a Virginia certified *Pyrotechnician* - both issued by the Virginia State Fire Marshal's Office (SFMO),

Line 14: Self-explanatory

Line 15: Pursuant to § 27-97.2 of the Code of Virginia any person - as an individual or as a representative of a company - who applies for a permit to manufacture, store, use, handle or sell explosives shall not have been convicted of any felonious act, or has had their rights restored by the Governor or other appropriate authority.

Line 16: Self-explanatory

Line 17: Fixed site – identified as a permanent location where explosives may be used on a periodic or continuous basis.

Non-fixed site – identified as a temporary location where explosives are used for a specific project or to accomplish a specific defined objective (e.g. building construction, roadway project, utilities).

Lines 18 through 21: Self-explanatory

Line 22:

- Type of rock
- Blast / Drill pattern
- Borehole diameter(s) and depth(s)
- Powder factor
- Overburden depth(s)
- Control of adverse effects: flyrock, ground vibrations, air vibrations, fumes and dust
- Pre-Blast survey
