

# Additional Application Information:

- To ensure proper placement of the camper, a birth certificate and/or proof of address may be required.
- If your application date has passed, you may still apply for camp at anytime.
- · If you apply in the wrong tier application date, you will have to reapply on the correct date.
- If no space is available in the program requested, you will be placed on a waitlist. IF a space becomes available in a camp, you will be contacted by a staff member.
- Siblings of returning campers can apply during the same tier of application, even if they have not attended camp in the past.



# Camp Programs



## Traditional & Specialty Camps Summer Camp

#### **PAYMENTS**

Once you are registered for a camp program, you may choose a payment plan or pay in full. If you select to use a payment plan, it is required to setup the automatic payment plan with a credit card to be held on file.

- · A deposit of \$100 for Traditional Camps or \$50 per specialty camp will be due at the time of enrollment of camps.
- Payments will be charged on April 1, May 1 and June 1.

Staff reserve the right to remove your child from the camp program for any outstanding payments.

#### **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE**

We strive to provide access to all programs regardless of financial status. Financial Assistance is available for qualified FAIRFAX **CITY** residents only. Tax forms and/or proof of income are required. Financial aid will be based on a sliding scale. If you wish to apply for financial assistance, please contact us to make an appointment. Re-application is required every year.

**Deadline for financial** assistance for the camp program is June 1.

### **CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS**

To request a refund, a Refund Request Form must be completed. This form can be found at fairfaxva.gov/summercamp

If approved, refunds will be processed - minus a \$100 fee for full summer registration or minus a \$50 for weekly registrations.

No refunds will be given after June 1.

#### **COVID-19 Refund Procedures**

Refunds requested due to COVID-19 will only be given for confirmed positive cases or the need to quarantine due to confirmed direct/close contact.

No refunds will be given within 3 business days before the start date of a camp due to **COVID** reasoning.

Fairfax City reserves the right to cancel a camp if we believe it is in the best interest of participant health and safety. All individuals registered for a canceled camp program will receive a full refund of the registration fee.

#### **WAITLISTS**

Due to limited capacities, we will maintain a waitlist on a first-come, first-served basis.

**IF a spot opens up**, the Parks and Recreation staff will contact the waitlist in order to fill the spot. Please understand that our goal is to operate our camps at a safe maximum capacity.

#### **HEALTH PROFILE**

Once registered, all parents or guardians must complete a health profile on campdoc.com for their camper in order to attend camp. This includes all emergency contacts, health history, pickup authorizations and other important information for camp staff to keep your child as safe as possible. If your child attended camp previously you will need to go in and update or approve previous information.

Children will not be permitted to attend camp without a completed profile.

#### **REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS**

The Fairfax City is committed to the letter and spirit of the Americans with Disabilities Act. If your child has a disability or requires special attention for any reason, advanced notice is required to make accommodations. ## Safe at Camp

It is our top priority at Fairfax City Summer Camps to keep our campers and their families as safe as possible while attending our camps. During these uncertain times, we understand many things are changing on a daily basis and that can be very difficult for families.

Our program environment, policies, and procedures are set with guidance from:

- Fairfax County Department of Health
- City of Fairfax Government Officials and Staff
- Fairfax County Public Schools
- National Parks and Recreation Association
- American Camp Association

Our staff monitors and receives updates from these sources regularly and continually updates our policies and procedures so they are up to date.

### **TRADITIONAL & SPECIALITY CAMP STAFF TRAINING**

Fairfax City camp staff will have training on COVID-19 procedures training prior to the start of summer to keep all our camps as safe as possible.

### **GROUP COHORTING**

Larger camps will be broken down into small groups, within the camp site.

Smaller sized camps that share a building will be kept in their small groups and separated from other groups in the building with limited shared spaces.

### O: Will masks need to be worn while at the program?

A: Fairfax City Camps will follow Fairfax City and Fairfax County Public Schools polices in regards to mask wearing at the time of the start of camp.

### Q: Hand washing?

A: Consistent hand washing will be required. Hand sanitizer will also be available.

### Q: What cleaning precautions will be taken?

A: High touch areas such as door handles, supplies and restrooms will be cleaned in between uses and on a regular basis. Staff will conduct a daily morning and afternoon thorough cleaning. All cleaning products are from a list of vetted products by the CDC.

### **STAFF**

The City of Fairfax Parks and Recreation Department takes tremendous pride in our amazing camp staff. Many of our camp employees have worked in our camp program for several years. Each camp has a Site Director who manages the program. Specialists in areas of art and sports will visit each site every week to teach different activities. Each camp site has personnel who are trained in standard First Aid and hold a current CPR and AED certification. In order to provide the best care for your child, all staff is required to attend trainings before and throughout the summer.

### **DISCOUNTS**

### **Full Payment Discount**

A discount of \$50 will be applied if the application is paid in FULL within one week of acceptance to camp.

### Sibling Discount

A sibling discount will be applied for families registering for traditional camp with two or more children in the same household. A discount of \$50 off each child in a family of two or more. Qualifiers: A sibling is categorized as 'one of two or more individuals having one or both parents in common.'

### **OTHER INFORMATION**

A parent handbook will be available upon registration and online at fairfaxva.gov/summercamp.

It will provide more specific details on camp procedures, schedules, activities and policies.

All accepted families will receive an email prior to the start of camp with details about their specific camp site.

#### **Information Session**

A virtual information session will be held in the beginning of June for all registered camp families.

Families will have the opportunity to meet some of the camp staff, learn more about the camp day, and ask questions. We highly recommend you attend this session, but it is not mandatory.

If the paperwork is not received, the Parks and Recreation Department reserves the right to withdraw participants from the program. Children will not be allowed to attend camp without all paperwork completed and submitted to staff.




