#### Include only these items in your recycling bin:










Keep materials loose in the bin

Empty and rinse out all food residue

Labels and lids may be left on



Paper bags, newspaper, mail, magazines

CARDBOARD

Flattened boxes, toilet paper and paper towel rolls

Bottles, tubs

and jugs

Tin, aluminum, steel, and empty aerosol cans

#### DO NOT place these items in your recycling bin:



Do not bag recyclables leave items loose in the bin



No plastic bags or film packaging return to retailer



Bring glass to a Purple Can Club container, or place in trash



No food wrappers, bags, or packaging place in trash



No styrofoam or plastic takeout containers place in trash



No shredded paper compost or place in trash

### Glass Recycling

Glass is not accepted in curbside recycling. Glass should be reused, taken to one of the conveniently located Purple Can containers, or placed in the trash.
