

Know Your Rights

In the City of Fairfax, you are afforded rights, opportunity, and legal protection from discrimination under the City's Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Program. You can expect to be treated fairly and equitably, to have access to decision-making and to share feedback, and to receive full benefits of services, activities, and programs without delay.

If you believe that you, individually or as a member of a specific class of person, have been excluded from the participation in, been denied benefits, or subjected to discrimination and unequal treatment based upon race, color, or national origin, under any program or activity provided by the City of Fairfax, you have the right to file a formal Title VI complaint.
