Project Scope

- Improve streetscape including pedestrian walkway, landscaping, grading and storm water runoff









Typical Section

- 5 foot concrete sidewalk
- 2 foot grass utility strip
- Max 3:1 slope to existing grade

 - PCE Already Completed by VDOT


Impacts to Property Owners

 Permanent and temporary construction easements are required.

Plans minimize impacts to adjacent properties.

Where impacts cannot be avoided, City will collaborate with the property owner(s) to develop a landscape improvements plan.

ROW Acquisition Process

- Present project concept at public information meeting: September 30, 2014
- 2. Present intermediate plan at Public Hearing: September 29, 2015
- 3. Meet with affected property owners to discuss impacts and develop landscape improvements plan
- 4. Incorporate feedback from public hearing and property owner meetings into plans
- Develop Right-of-Way/Easement Plans to submit to VDOT to obtain authorization to initiate Easement Acquisition Process

ROW Acquisition Process

- 6. Conduct preliminary title research and prepare Valuation Reports to fairly assess the value of the required easements
- Present offer letters to affected property owner(s) and explain the documents
- 8. Meet with affected property owners to negotiate final value for necessary easements and address any outstanding concerns
- 9. Execute easement acquisition documents
- 10. Close on the property and distribute negotiated compensation amounts

Project Schedule

- Public Hearing September 29, 2015
- Respond to Comments and Finalize Design Fall 2015
- ROW Acquisition Winter 2015
- Advertisement Date Spring 2016
- Construction Summer 2016

Project Cost Estimate

Project Costs:

Engineering (PE): \$76,000

Construction Easement Acquisition: \$165,000

Construction (CN): \$636,444

Total: \$877,444

Project Funding

RSTP – Federal \$257,444

Revenue Sharing – State \$310,000

30% Transportation Tax – Local Match \$310,000

Total Funding: \$877,444
