Edge Conditions between St. Leo's school and park

Erosion on paths near tennis courts

'The Bowl' • large open free play space

Limited Parking • 87 spaces (4 ADA) • Overflow at Sherwood

Traffic Congestion • no traffic signal • access only from Old Lee Highway

Park Access • pedestrians • vehicles • crosswalks don't align w/ park entry

No permanent public restrooms

Aging Facilities • skatepark • playgrounds • fitness stations
